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ABSTRACT

The wake of the racial awakening summer of 2020, which led to an interest convergence for racial justice along with the subsequent chilling of racial justice progress serves as the context for this engaging and thought provoking panel. Further contributing to the significance of this panel has been the misinformation, dog whistling, and weaponizing tactics related to critical race theory.
