Research on Information Literacy for All in China: The Practical Exploration of the "Three Realistic Scenarios Content System"

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ABSTRACT

In recent years, information literacy and its education have gradually attracted wide attention from all countries in the world. With the social progress, scientific and technological development and the continuous change of information education environment, the traditional system has been difficult to meet the public's needs for information literacy education, personal development and lifelong learning.
